Simple payment instruction transmission

Simply transmit your instructions from your PC or mainframe via modem or the Internet using Scotiabank's proprietary communication programs or other commercially available communication programs.

Scotiabank supports a number of secure communication methods for transferring files including our proprietary program Scotia Talk for Windows, Secure Shell, HTTPS/SSL, FTP with Security and Message Authentication Codes.

Payments can also be restricted to pre-determined entities, providing an extra control mechanism.

Comprehensive reports available

Standard reports, available in hard copy or electronically, give you the tools you need for control and customer service.

- **Acknowledgement Report (ACK)** – Confirms the Bank has received your payment file. It also indicates whether the file is acceptable or unacceptable for further processing.
- **Input Validation Report (IVR)** – Provides the results of detailed editing that has been performed as your file was processed. Detailed information is provided so that you can take action on items that have been rejected.
- **Returned Item Notification Report (RIN)** – Provides details of EFT payments returned by the recipient's financial institution for reasons such as account closures.

Full control of user passwords and privileges are retained by the user. SPW is also flexible enough to involve two individuals for entering and approving payments, and adding users.
